Dear Parents,

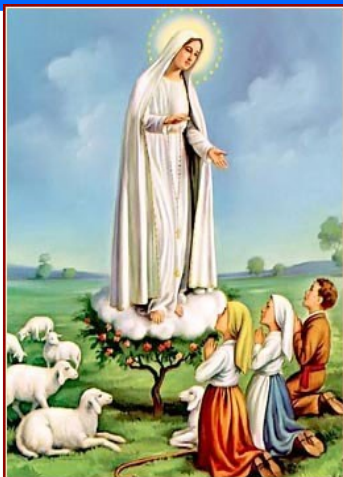
Thanks to all who have sent in your Intent to Return Forms. If you have misplaced your intent form, please don't hesitate to give Suzi Dutro a call and we will send one to you. This week we are mailing the tuition contracts to each family with a suggested scheduled time to meet to discuss the tuition amount designated for each family. This is a "Fair Share" school so it is an opportunity to discuss your financial needs before determining tuition responsibility. We have revised the tuition contract to include fees paid during the school year. This will streamline the collection of fees such as field trips, registration and auction projects. This give parents the opportunity to either write one check for all the fees or include the fee amount with the tuition; thereby spreading out the payment on a ten or twelve month plan. I look forward to the meetings, as this gives me an opportunity to clarify concerns and answer questions. If there is a need to change the scheduled time, please contact Suzi Dutro at the school office.
